## Mountain Biking

### Shoreline Rd to Matarohero Valley Rd

From Riverside Rd, turn right into Omeid Rd, over the fence at the end of Omeid Rd, through a farm track to Matarohero Valley Rd. Put your bike over the fence and head for the car park. Turn right into Matarohero Valley Rd, left on Omeid Rd - 13 km later at 13 km loop from here on.

**Goodwin Road** - via Matarohero road  
 From Riverside Rd, turn right into Goodwin Rd for a tough, steep ride to the yards. (1 hour)

**Longbush Reserve** - via Matarohero road  
 Continue down Riverside Rd (past Omeid) to Longbush Reserve, take a walk around the reserve and head back to town. (1.5 hours)

**Mander Road Mountain Bike Park** - via Matarohero road  
 Some scenic rides for all abilities, if you like jumping the adrenaline then this is the place to go. Expect to get dirty, permit required and can be purchased from Adventure Mountain, Shire or Omeid Cycle Shop.

## Road Riding

Gisborne has a superb climate for riding and some great quiet country roads to enjoy. The New Zealand Cycle May will event with mander ride to Omeid via Matarohero Road. Stop at the quiet valley roads and then a scenic bike ride around our city.
