Other Mechanisms

- ◆ Adjoining landowner to esplanade reserves and strips will be encouraged to maintain these areas and be part of the overall development process when tracks are created.
- ◆ Schools in the immediate vicinity will be approached to be part of the planting scheme of street, linkage or neighbourhood reserve beautification.
- ◆ Sponsorship from local nurseries and business will be sought in any developments.
- ◆ Community groups with audited accounts will be requested to undertake specific projects such as street planting to raise funding.
- ◆ Advertising will be sought to encourage further promotion where possible.
- ◆ Iwi educational establishments have forestry trainee groups, which can be utilised to remove unwanted trees. They would generally expect a koha to contribute to the paying off of their chainsaws.
- ◆ The Corrections Department of Community Probation Service can be contacted to maintain crown or public owned land. Workers currently maintain areas such as Titirangi and SH.35 road reserve between the City and Wainui ensuring landscaping has a good chance of survival.
