

# Alcohol Premises Compliance Certificate

Sections 100, 105, 120 or 127 - Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012



## What is a Alcohol Premises Compliance Certificate? (APCC)

This is a certificate produced by the Gisborne District Council. Its purpose is to inform the licence applicant of any Council requirements or consents (e.g local alcohol policy requirements, town planning or building requirements) relevant to obtaining a licence. An APCC must be applied for **before** a licence application is made, especially if the premise has never held a licence, or a variation to an existing licence is sought following building renovations.

## The following must be attached before the application will be accepted for processing

- Completed application form
- Fee paid
- A scale plan of the proposed premises showing -
  - those parts of the premises that are to be used for the sale or supply of alcohol
  - any intended changes to an existing premises
  - each entrance to the premises and the principal entrance identified
  - any amenities whether proposed or existing
- Covering letter detailing:
  - the general nature of the business to be conducted by the applicant if the licence is granted
  - the proposed days and hours for the sale and supply of alcohol.
