Why so many different projects

- Geographically cover different areas

- Maintaining interest if scope broad
- Manageable project size
- Project management proposed scope creep, effectiveness/efficiencies
- Resourcing GDC (many other roles to perform as well) and expertise
- Differing time restraints legislated and other related project timelines
- Changing legislation, policies, standards etc.

Purpose

Sustainability

To develop a sustainable strategy that identifies the preferred management of coastal hazards affecting Wainui Beach

Broader Context

We will be taking into consideration the wider economic, environmental, social, recreational and cultural context

Broad Acceptance

Our goal is to achieve a WBMS that has broad acceptance amongst the community because it will provide a framework for future development and decisions related to Wainui Beach

Proposed Project Scope – Overview

- Consider threat to homes from coastal erosion
- Protection of nationally recognised surf breaks
- Environmental concerns
- Beach access & future of dune protection works southern end of beach.
- We understand there are diverse interests in these matters amongst the Wainui/Okitu community.

Engagement with community will seek to balance these interests



Proposed Scope includes

- Review current WBMS Strategy
- Understand natural coastal processes
- Understand & consider divergent views
 - o community & experts
- Identify & consider related legislation, national policies & strategies.
- Consider known hazard information & relevant planning controls
- Understanding existing & alternate engineering solutions

Out of scope The scope does not include

- Wainui Community Planning (Wainui/Okitu Community Plan)
- Stormwater, wastewater and water reticulation
- Onsite wastewater disposal
- Volume and quality of discharge into Wainui & Hanamatua Streams
- Flood hazard overlays Lloyd George Road

Wainui/Hanamatua Streams

- WBMS addressing coastal hazards
- Low/medium flows more a coastal concern
- Freshwater plan
- Sponge Bay concerns well understood


