- No tree sleeves will be available until early July.
- Please check our website for current prices. Please note there will be a \$1 levy added to the price of poles planted under the government subsidised schemes such as ECFP
- Pole load outs at the Waerenga-o-Kuri Nursery will occur on Tuesdays and Wednesdays only
