1.1 My name is KATHERINE CAVE. I have lived in Auckland since 1992 but was born in Gisborne. I return to Gisborne often to visit my family.

1.2 My family built the property at 4 Tuahine Crescent in the late 1960s and I have an

interest in that property.

1.3 I filed a submission in response to the resource consent application primarily due to

a concern that 'end effects' be appropriately addressed.

1.4 My family is a joint applicant for and is fully supportive of the application for an existing

use rights certificate.

1.5 I am fully satisfied that the issue of 'end effects' can and will be appropriately

managed and no longer wish to be heard as a submitter in response to the resource

consent application. I formally withdraw that submission.

1.6 For the avoidance of doubt, I support both the resource consent application and the

application for an existing use rights certificate.

1.7 I am providing this statement to record my position and to state that I can give evidence

as a witness to assist the Commissioner as might be required.

1.8 If required I could give evidence remotely as I will be in Auckland on the hearing dates

but I will continue to liaise with Mr Cameron as Counsel for the applicant to ensure I

have a clear understanding of the evidence and can provide instructions to him to

ensure my family's position can be fully understood in the event of any issues arising

that might affect our ongoing consideration of this matter.
