Mr Caves proposal to replace the existing foreshore protection works which are badly run down with a sloping rock wall on the same profile as the sloping rock wall to the south of the concrete groyne/wall appears to be eminently sensible. It therefore has my full support. The existing rock wall has proven very successful protecting the toe of the cliff from erosion and allowing the sand to come back in. It has also allowed unimpeded public access along that part of the foreshore.

Other reasons for supporting Mr Caves work are as follows.

- The rock wall will follow the same alignment and profile of the sloping rock wall to the south of the existing concrete ground and will therefore not look out of place.
- The work will enable the ugly dangerous and now largely ineffective protruding railway iron and log structure to be removed in the location of the work..
- It is noted planting will be encouraged to give a natural look which is a bonus.
- The properties concerned will be protected from erosion.  
The sloping nature of the ~~road~~<sup>rock</sup> wall should assist in diffusing the wave energy and promote sand recovery like it has on the south side of the concrete groyne.

For these reasons I fully support Mr Caves proposal which I note is also to be constructed on his private land.



- Planning Creep. If this application is consented it will set a precedent and others along the sea front will want rock protection.
- I am concerned in how the wooden piles tie into the existing works. The right angle seems severe and, in my opinion, will cause problems for the residents who live just north of the proposed works. As well as putting at risk the Esplanade Reserve directly to the north of the proposed revetment.
- Is it even needed? We know storm erosion at Wainui Beach is episodic. Erosion can hit anywhere at any time. How serious is the problem in front of these properties? Have any 'soft' measures been considered?
- I have concerns in regards to the amount of time this project will take and the amount of upheaval the heavy machinery will cause. The community could well lose access to enjoying this part of the beach for the better part of a summer.

In summary: I have long opposed any hard engineering along Wainui Beach and have been an advocate for a managed retreat. However, I believe that those of us who live on the edge would rather be in an evacuation type scenario than have to relocate our homes. That's fine by me, just please stop asking for rock revetments or other hard engineered solutions that are ultimately unsustainable.

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

I have owned the property at 60 Murphy Rd since 2001 and lived there since 2007. Over those years there have been two major applications for rock revetments that impinge on my frontage and I have opposed both. The first would have had rocks all the way from the groyne to the Wainui Stream. Those would have materially affected my place in multiple ways and I was concerned for the end-effect at the creek and beyond. The second was for rocks from the groyne to some uncertain point north of the Tuahine Accessway. I was concerned that the end effect would impact the integrity of my frontage and those of my neighbours.

The previous proposals included higher revetments that were more gently sloped to their peak to distribute wave energy more widely. Even then there seemed to be insufficient consideration of the inevitable rising sea level. This design which is lower and is less obtrusive but I question its efficacy in the changing climate. I have not previously seen a squared off end such as in the current proposal; previous designs had the end tapered and tied into the bank to minimise the wave damage beyond the end.

I acknowledge that the present proposal does not look any worse than the rock and rail structures presently in place and is not on public land.

#### **REASONS FOR OPPOSITION:**

- In principle, I am against rock changes north of the groyne. I note in the NZ Coastal Policy Statement that hard structures to protect private development are undesirable. I agree with that.
- I question: what is the problem that this rock revetment is intended to solve? I have inspected that area again carefully – I walk past it most days. The rocks and rail irons have not moved in years as far as I can tell and form a significant barrier against the bank. Most importantly, the vegetation above those rocks is lush and thriving (see Figures 1 & 2 below). There is one small bare patch and one half-dead Pampas grass which will leave a gap when it finally expires. It would seem to me that engineering work below would cause damage to the present shrubs and trees unless great care is taken. But why would one remove these enthusiastic shrubs and trees allowing for great vulnerability of the bank well before newly planted salt-resistant plants would grow to effective size?
- There is minimal mention of the end-effect of this new wall as it is assumed that the contiguous existing old wall will prevent that. I believe that there will be important disruption of the existing and remaining rock wall during the engineering works, making the area around the accessway more vulnerable to wave action. My concern at all times has been predominantly about the diversion of wave energy from the rocks to the adjoining bank where a rock wall ends. The end-effect is very evident south of the groyne where the bank directly beyond the end of the revetment has eroded markedly.

- The structure most at risk for damage from end effect in this application is the public accessway. I know from previous discussions with GDC engineers that they have been quite content to sacrifice the Tuahine access as they find it difficult to maintain. This would give them the perfect opportunity to close it permanently. The nearest other access is at Lloyd George Road, since previous Councils have given private landowners permission to block public access along much of this end of the beach.
- I see this application, if granted, as precedent for all those keen on rock walls to apply to extend the rock along their frontages – either because if it's good enough for one it will be good enough for another, or because of loss of integrity of their frontages because of end-effect.
- I do not envisage this design proposed would have any adverse effect on my frontage, but the closer new rocks extend north the more likely I am to suffer end effect.
- I do not see evidence in the application that significant sea-level rise has been factored into the design. I quote from the 2017 Ministry for the Environment paper "Adapting to sea-level rise" advice to Local Govt, for existing coastal development and asset planning: "For planning and decision timeframes out to 2120, councils should use a minimum transitional value for sea level rise of 1 metre relative to the 1986-2005 baseline".
- The accessway will be closed during the engineering works, which the applicant estimates at 1 month. I have no confidence in that estimate. The previous applicant thought his work would take 20 weeks. Almost every engineering task seems to take longer rather than shorter times than proposed. Even if it is 1 month that means the access to beach there closed for that period – more than a minor disruption in my view – and there will be heavy vehicles up and down the beach every tide for 28 (or 20 if a 5 day week) days. That too is more than minor in effect.

#### **SUMMARY:**

I oppose all new rocks on Wainui beach. I think those already there should be left just as they are.

I do not see that the applicant has made a case for the need for this revetment. I fear that the disturbance from engineering and replanting a well-vegetated site will do more harm than good.

I believe that rising sea level will soon overcome all the efforts to protect these banks; that should be accepted and a different approach engaged by home owners.

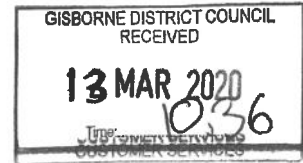
