1. I live at 9 Dominey Street, Inner Kaiti.
2. I am a patched member of the Dominey Street gang which comprises 5 boys aged 6 – 9 and Pickles the Cat. We spend a lot of time playing in the Owen Stream and wandering through private property to the ngahere in the school grounds.
3. Wolfgang Kanz and Mike Greef visited me to discuss the issues raised in my submission. They listened and Wolfgang subsequently visited and emailed me about those issues.
4. I appreciate the professionalism and proactive approach to problem-solving shown by the applicant.
5. Wolfgang Kanz initiated an ecological study of the stream which took place last week. There is a need to improve day to day management of this stream (e.g., rubbish removal) and its ecological and amenity values (e.g., by weed clearance and planting). In a small way, local people are doing some of this work however a coordinated, well-funded project would achieve better results.
6. In November last year, Wolfgang lent me a fish trap which I placed in the small pool where we'd seen fish and we duly caught banded kokopu. During 2020 and up until March 2021, the number of fish ranged from 3 to 7. I have not seen any fish in this pool since just before the pre-hearing meeting held on 23 March 2021.
7. In general, I am pleased with the applicant's initiative with respect to the Seymour Road overflow i.e., to reduce it to a tertiary overflow and to re-activate the Owen Road line as a tertiary overflow. I am satisfied that this approach would minimise the level of risk to the stream from overflows if fully implemented.
8. Implementation/operation requires clear and specific conditions of consent. Conditions 19-21 of Ian Mayhew's evidence need more certainty e.g., a date of completion as well as a date for commencement of construction.
9. I consider that the conditions for monitoring and reporting should provide for an independent peer review panel of appropriately qualified experts to evaluate the annual, five yearly and ten yearly reports (proposed conditions 27-30) and any s128 RMA review undertaken in accordance with proposed conditions 32-33. The panel's evaluation should accompany the provision of these required reports to the consent authority, WMC, TWRG et al. The consent holder should fund this panel.
